- 1. (6 points) **Spot the Violation:** Check the box next to each item below that *is* an academic integrity violation in this course. If an item is not a violation, then leave the box unchecked. Assume that both Ahmed and Roudha are students in the course.
 - \Box Ahmed hires a private tutor who helps him study by solving old quizzes and exams with him.
 - □ Ahmed hires a private tutor who helps him study by giving him some new programming exercises to solve and then walking him through solving them.
 - \Box Ahmed hires a private tutor who helps him with homework 1 by providing him with a solution to the assignment.
 - □ Ahmed hires a private tutor who helps him with homework 1 by discussing the high-level concepts with him, but does not provide him with a solution or look at his code.
 - \Box Roudha's friend (who isn't a CMU student) helps her study by solving old quizzes and exams with her.
 - \Box While solving the homework, Ahmed has a strange error message and reads it to Roudha. She mentions how she solved a similar error.
 - □ Roudha's friend (who isn't a CMU student) helps her with homework 1 by discussing the high-level concepts with her, but does not provide her with a solution or look at her code.
 - \Box Roudha's friend (who is also a student in 15-112 this semester) helps her with homework 1 by discussing the high-level concepts with her, but does not provide her with a solution or look at her code.
 - \Box Roudha tells Ahmed about some ideas for good testcases to test his solution to homework 2.
 - □ While solving the homework, Ahmed has a strange error message and Roudha takes a look at the error for him and then shows him that one line of his code is not indented properly.
 - □ Ahmed finds some code on the internet that helps him solve the homework and uses copy/paste to insert it into his code.
 - \Box Ahmed finds some code on the internet that helps him solve the homework and types it into his code by hand without using copy/paste.
